



## 2020 Wamego Independence Day Parade Guidelines & Information

On Sunday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 6 pm, Wamego will host its 149th Annual Independence Day Parade. You are invited to be a part of the celebration! If you would like to enter the parade then please complete the entry form and mail, email or hand-deliver it to the Wamego Area Chamber of Commerce office no later than Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020. We will send parade line-up instructions to you **by email so it is imperative that you provide an email address.**

**ENTRY IS FREE for all participants.**

### GUIDELINES

Please remember that each parade entry must have **easy to see and read** signs, banners or uniforms identifying your group or sponsor. All elected officials and political candidates must provide their own car and signage. The highest point on your float should be no higher than 13 feet above the ground. **We request that all entries have some patriotic or theme related decoration displayed. This increases enjoyment of those viewing the parade.**

### LINE-UP

Parade line-up begins at 4:00 p.m. in the Wamego High School parking lot, Lincoln Ave. or Railroad St. Specific instructions will be forwarded when entry form is received. **Parade entries must be in their line-up area NO LATER than 5:30 p.m.** This is very important so that contest judges have time to judge entries and to ensure that the parade begins promptly at 6:00 p.m.

### CANDY

Absolutely **NO CANDY is to be thrown from moving vehicles.** You may WALK along-side your float/vehicle and hand out candy.

### FLOAT CONTEST

#### ***2020 Theme: Freedom Still Rings***

There is no obligation, but everyone is encouraged to enter the float contest. If you choose to enter please use the theme as your inspiration. Prominently display your group or business name. No special contest registration, entry form or entry fee is necessary to enter the contest. Just send in a completed parade entry form. We will have a marked entrance for float contest entries.

**Prizes will be awarded in three categories:**

- (1) Best portrayal of the theme: ***Freedom Still Rings***
- (2) Greatest display of Patriotism.
- (3) Most unique idea or clever use of materials.

Fill out the entry form and mail, email or hand-deliver it to the Wamego Chamber office no later than Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. We look forward to your creativity and participation!
